Delete paragraph (b) and substitute the following paragraph:</p> <p align="center">“(b) in section 3A, by repealing subsections (1) and (2) and substituting the following subsection:</p> <p align="center">“(1) A person referred to in section 3(1) is eligible on every fifth anniversary of the date he ceased to be President for a revised pension equivalent to –</p> <p align="center">(a) the salary payable to the incumbent on that date; or</p> <p align="center">(b) three-fourths of the salary payable to the incumbent on that date, where he has exercised the option under section 3(2).”.</p>
5	<p>A. In paragraph (a), after the words “inclusive of” delete the words “personal allowance and”.</p> <p>B. In paragraph (b), delete the new section 4A and substitute the following new section:</p> <p align="center">“Review of pension 4A. A person, including a retired Prime Minister, is eligible on every fifth anniversary of the date he ceased to be Prime Minister for a revised Prime Minister’s pension equivalent to –</p> <p align="center">(a) the salary payable to the incumbent on that date; or</p>

	(b) three-fourths of the salary payable to the incumbent on that date, where he has exercised the option under section 4(2).”.
6	<p>A. In paragraph (a), after the words “inclusive of” delete the words “personal allowance and”.</p> <p>B. In paragraph (c), delete the new section 11A and substitute the following new section:</p> <p>“Review of pension 11A. A person, including a retired Judge, is eligible on every fifth anniversary of the date he ceased to be a Judge for a revised pension –</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(a) calculated on the basis of the pensionable emoluments payable to the incumbent on that date; or</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(b) at the rate of three-fourths of the revised pension payable under paragraph (a), where he has exercised the option under section 11(1).”.</p>
7	<p>A. Delete.</p> <p>B. Renumber clauses accordingly.</p>
8	In paragraph (b), insert after the word “prescribe” , the words “, except that an Order under this paragraph shall not affect a person who is registered under subsection (1) prior to the coming into force of the Order” .
9	In subsection (7), delete the word “(1)” and substitute the word “(6)” .
