Control within the Public Service

Head 05 – Parliament

- The Office of the Parliament should complete the tagging of all inventory using the QR Code Label Printing System by June 30, 2017.
- The Office of the Parliament should seek to reduce its expenditure for the replacement equipment.

Response:

- i. The Office of the Parliament has noted the recommendations of the Committee. Tagging of the inventory in the Office of the Parliament using the QR Code Label Printing System has been completed however, tagging of the inventory at the Office of the Leader of the Opposition will be completed by June 29, 2017.
- ii. The budgetary allocation for the purchasing of equipment was significantly reduced, therefore, the expenditure for replacement equipment has been reduced.
