The Sixteenth Report of the Public Administration and Appropriations Committee on an Examination into the implementation of the Public Sector Investment Programme

The Trinidad and Tobago Police Service hereby submits its responses to as follows:

Recommendation: The Trinidad and Tobago Police Service should fill the two vacancies within the Project Implementation Unit by March 31, 2019.

Response: The positions of Programme Manager and Civil Engineer Technician were filled on January 2, 2019.

Recommendation: The Trinidad and Tobago Police Service should submit a status report to the Committee on the expansion of the Valencia Police Station by February 15, 2019.

Response: The expansion of the Valencia Police Station will be undertaken in the Fiscal Year 2018/2019. The parcel of land adjacent to the existing Police Station was vested in the Ministry of National Security for the relocation of the Valencia Police Post carpark by Cabinet Minute No. 1927 of November 8, 2018. There is an unfinished concrete structure in the carpark which will be refurbished and utilised for male and female dormitories. When the dormitories move into the refurbished building the units within the Police Post would have additional space to expand their operations. The project will be tendered and awarded as soon as the Service gets some release of funds.
