The Twenty-Third Report of the Public Accounts (Enterprises) Committee on the Examination of the Audited Financial Statements of the InvestTT Limited for the years 2014 to 2017

I refer to your letter dated September 26, 2019 on the captioned subject. In this context, the recommendations of the Public Accounts (Enterprises) Committee (PAEC) as outlined in pages 16-24 were reviewed. Of reference to the Ministry of Works and Transport was the recommendation outlined at item 5 page 20.

In light of the aforementioned, the Ministry of Trade and Industry was consulted and has identified the operationalization of the fixed Container Scanner at the Port of Port of Spain as a key reform, aligned to the EODB in Trinidad and Tobago. As it relates to a status update on this reform, it should be noted that the Fixed Container Scanner was operationalized in August 2018 and at present scans approximately 1341 containers monthly (Based on a seven month average from March 2019 – September 2019).
