1. THE COMMITTEE

1.1 BACKGROUND

At a sitting of the House of Representatives held on Friday October 15, 2010, Mr. Clifton De Couteau, MP presented a Petition on behalf of the Organization known as **THE WAY OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO** (hereinafter referred to as “**The Promoters**”) of Knolly Street, Princes Town seeking leave of the House for the promoters to proceed with the introduction of a Private Bill for the incorporation of the said organization. Leave was granted and the necessary documents were lodged with the Clerk of the House in the First Session of the 10th Parliament.

The relevant notices were published in the Trinidad and Tobago Gazette and the Trinidad Guardian Newspaper, informing the public of the intended introduction of a Private Bill for the incorporation of “The Way of Trinidad and Tobago”.

An objection to the Bill was received from “**The United Way of Trinidad and Tobago**” via letter dated December 17, 2010.

The Bill entitled “**The Way of Trinidad and Tobago (Incorporation) Bill, 2010**” was then introduced and read a First time in the House of Representatives on Friday February 04, 2011.

The Bill was read a second time on Friday February 18, 2011 and in accordance with Standing Order 83(8), referred to a Special Select Committee comprising the following Members:

1.2 MEETINGS

The Committee held four (4) meetings on Friday April 1, 2011; Friday May 6, 2011; Friday May 27, 2011 and Friday June 03, 2011.

At the first meeting held on April 1, 2011, the Committee received oral submissions from both the Promoters of and the Objectors to the Bill.

The Promoters, “The Way of Trinidad and Tobago”, was represented by:

- Mr. Premchand Harricharan - President
- Mr. Robert Boodoosingh - Legal Counsel
- Mr. Wayne Williams - Accountant

and the following persons represented the Objectors, the United Way of Trinidad and Tobago:

- Mr. Ian Benjamin - Advocate Attorney at Law
- Ms. Pamela Francis - Chief Executive Officer

In addition to taking oral evidence from the Promoters, your Committee examined a copy of the Private Bill entitled, “The Way of Trinidad and Tobago (Incorporation) Bill, 2010” and considered the following documents:

- (i) A copy of the audited Financial Report for the period 2001 to 2003;
- (ii) A copy of the Financial Report and Accounts for the year 2007;
- (iii) List of Registered Members;
- (iv) The Constitution of the Way of Trinidad & Tobago;
- (v) Copies of Minutes held for the years 2008 and 2009; and
- (vi) Copies of “*The Way Magazine*”

However, the Committee was unable to complete its deliberations before the end of

the First Session of the 10th Parliament. The Committee therefore submitted its report to Parliament and recommended that the Bill be re-introduced in the Second Session and be referred to a new Committee which should be mandated to continue consideration of this matter. The Committee further recommended that the House authorize the new Committee adopt as part of its records the work undertaken by the previous Committee.

This report was adopted on June 3, 2011.

2. INTRODUCTION OF HOR BILL NO. 24 OF 2011

In the Second Session (2011/2012) of the 10th Parliament, H.O.R Bill No. 24 of 2011, entitled **“The Way of Trinidad and Tobago (Incorporation) (No.2) Bill, 2011”** was introduced and read a first time on November 11, 2011.

2.1 Appointment of Committee

At a sitting of the House of Representatives held on Friday November 18, 2011, the aforementioned Bill was read a Second time, and in accordance with Standing Order 83(8) referred to a Special Select Committee comprising of the following Members:

*“to consider and report on a Private Bill entitled **“AN ACT for the incorporation of the Way of Trinidad and Tobago and for matters incidental thereto”**, along with the work undertaken by the previous committee appointed in the First Session of the 10th Parliament.*

2.4 *Meetings*

Your Committee held two (2) Meetings on Thursday January 19, 2012 and Thursday February 09, 2012. Minutes of the proceedings are at pgs. 7-13 of the APPENDIX.

3. WORK OF THE COMMITTEE

As mandated, your Committee considered the work undertaken by the previous committee appointed in the First Session of the 10th Parliament.

As part of the deliberative process, your Committee requested of “The Way of Trinidad and Tobago”, the submission of a name approval certificate from the Registrar General’s Department. Your Committee also asked the Registrar General to facilitate this request.

At its Second Meeting, held on February 09, 2012, your Committee examined the responses submitted by “The Way of Trinidad & Tobago dated January 30, 2012, February 01, 2012 and February 06, 2012 (**See APPENDIX**).

Your Committee also considered the response received from the Registrar General dated February 08, 2012 in connection with the above request. (**See APPENDIX**)

4. FINDINGS

Your Committee noted that an application for the reservation of the name “The Way of Trinidad and Tobago” was approved in 2007 by the Registrar General’s Department. However, the Promoters failed to renew the name reservation at the end of the ninety (90) day period, thereby invalidating the process.

In correspondence from the Registrar General dated February 08, 2012, the Committee noted that the application for use of the name, “The Way of Trinidad and Tobago” was found to be undesirable on January 30, 2012 because of two similarly named companies registered:

- The United Way of Trinidad and Tobago and
- Lead the Way (Trinidad) Ltd

5. CONCLUSION

After careful examination of the Clauses and Preamble of the Bill and consideration of all the evidence, the Committee is not satisfied that the facts and allegations presented in the Bill have been proved.

6. RECOMMENDATIONS

Your Committee therefore recommends that:

- (i) organizations desirous of being incorporated by an Act of Parliament must provide a name approval certificate duly authenticated by the Registrar General in addition to required documentation.
- (ii) in the event that the name approval certificate expires before the Committee completes its business, the Promoters should be mandated to apply to have the name approval certificate renewed.

- (iii) the Bill be rejected by the House of Representatives.

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INTRODUCTION

1.1 The Chairman called the meeting to order at 11:22 a.m. and welcomed members to the first meeting of the Committee.

Quorum

The Chairman advised Members that in accordance with Standing Order 80(5) of the House of Representatives the quorum for a Special Select Committee of the House is three (3) members, inclusive of the Chairman.

CONSIDERATION OF THE TERMS OF REFERENCE

The Chairman indicated to Members that the terms of reference of the Committee were:

*"to consider and report on a Bill entitled, "An Act for the incorporation of
the Way of Trinidad and Tobago and matters incidental thereto" along with the*

work undertaken by the previous Committee appointed in the first session of the 10th Parliament.

EXAMINATION OF THE REPORT

- 2.1 The Chairman asked Members to review the Report of the last Committee and make any comments, suggestions and recommendations as necessary.
- 2.2 Minutes contained in the report were amended as follows:
- (i) On page 15 under the heading “Examination of the Objectors of the Bill the United Way of Trinidad and Tobago” 4.1 insert “United Way of Trinidad and Tobago to join the meeting.”
 - (ii) On page 17 under the heading “Absent” it should be “Excused.”

MATTERS ARISING FROM REPORT OF COMMITTEE

- 3.1 A member pointed out that the documents requested from both “The United Way of Trinidad and Tobago” and “The Way of Trinidad and Tobago” were examined at the last meeting.
- 3.2 However, the documents provided by “The Way of Trinidad and Tobago” were found to be inconclusive and additional documentation was required from the entity. There was a recommendation by the Committee to consider requesting a name change from the entity “The Way of Trinidad and Tobago” which would speed up the process.
- 3.3 The Chair advised that the Committee could not change the name of the entity. The Committee could only report that the entity “The Way of Trinidad and Tobago” failed to provide the necessary documentation. It was established that the authority to approve or disapprove a name is the Registrar General’s Department of the Ministry of Legal Affairs.
- 3.4 The Chair then enquired of the Secretariat whether a request was sent to the Registrar General for a name search. Secretariat answered in the negative.
- 3.6 Another Member then pointed out that “The Way of Trinidad and Tobago” never reached further than a name search. The entity was never registered and no proof of a name search was provided. Other members agreed with this and requested that a report be submitted to Parliament stating that the documentation provided by the entity was inconclusive and based on the Committee’s deliberations; recommend that the entity not be incorporated by an Act of Parliament.
- 3.7 The Chair then stated that the only way the entity could be blocked from being incorporated by an Act of Parliament was if the Registrar General determined that the name could not be used. The Chair then pointed out that in his examination of the documents pertaining to “The Way of Trinidad and Tobago” there were feedback reports on the words “International” and “Trinidad and Tobago”, and that there was no specific request for a name search.
- 3.8 The Chair then recommended that the Secretariat request from “The Way of Trinidad and Tobago”, an official name approval certificate from the Registrar General’s

Department, Ministry of Legal Affairs. This was approved by the members of the Committee. It was determined that the deadline date for the receipt of the official name approval certificate would be February 08, 2012, failing which the Committee would conclude that the entity "The Way of Trinidad and Tobago" does not exist.

- 4.1 There being no other business the Chairman thanked Members for their attendance and the staff of the Parliament.

(ii) On page 3 under the heading "Work of the Committee" last line of paragraph insert "the Organization's name "The Way of Trinidad and Tobago" was not reserved and available for incorporation."

(iii) On page 3 under the heading "The Report", insert "Your Committee examined the response submitted by the "The Way of Trinidad and Tobago as well as correspondence from the Registrar General's Department, Ministry of Legal Affairs and found that the name "The Way of Trinidad and Tobago" was not approved, and as such the Committee was unable to recommend that Parliament incorporate the organization."

(iv) It was recommended that persons or groups desirous of incorporating an organization by an Act of Parliament should provide in addition to all the documents and formalities requested by Parliament, a name approval certificate from the Registrar General's Department, Ministry of Legal Affairs. It was also recommended that a letter from the Registrar General herself accompany the name approval certificate.

(v) It was also suggested that in the event the name approval certificate expires before the end of the Working Committee, the organization must renew the name approval certificate.

MATTERS ARISING

4.1 The Chairman referred Members to a letter received from Mr. Harricharan dated January 30th 2012 in which a copy of a Certificate of Renewal of Trade Mark was submitted.

4.2 However, this was not the document originally requested and so another letter was sent to Mr. Harricharan requesting the name approval certificate.

4.3 The Chairman referred Members to another letter received by Mr. Harricharan requesting a time extension until February 23rd 2012.

4.4 A copy of the name search and name reservation form was submitted on February

06th 2012 which established that the organization's name "The Way of Trinidad and Tobago" was approved and reserved until April 17th 2007. However, name reservations are valid only for ninety (90) days.

4.5 The Chairman then referred Members to a letter received from the Registrar General's Department, Ministry of Legal Affairs which stated that the application for the use of the name "The Way of Trinidad and Tobago" was found to be undesirable on January 30th 2012.

4.6 It was then agreed by all that the Committee could not move forward and could not recommend the organization to be incorporated by an Act of Parliament.

4.7 The Chair then instructed the Secretariat to draft the Final Report.

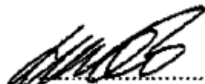

AN ACT for the Incorporation of The Way of Trinidad

WHEREAS it was established in Trinidad and Tobago, an Preamble
Organisation known as “The Way of Trinidad and Tobago”

And whereas The Way of Trinidad and Tobago is a
fellowship of the followers of the Lord Jesus Christ for the
manifestation of the more than abundant life. A follower of

The Way is filled with and manifests power from on high, holy spirit and freely avails himself of fellowship meetings for spiritual nurture and growth. The Way fellowship is cemented together by the Spirit of God with each believer being transformed by the renewing of his mind according to the Word of God.

And whereas it is expedient that The Way of Trinidad and Tobago be incorporated for the purposes set out in this Act:

Enactment	ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as follows:
Short title	1. This Act may be cited as The Way of Trinidad and Tobago (Incorporation) (No. 2) Act, 2011.
Interpretation	2. In this Act— “Annual General Meeting” means the annual general meeting of the followers of the Way; “Association” means the Association established in section 3; and “The Way International” means a Biblical research teaching and fellowship ministry situated in New Knoxville, Ohio, in the United States of America;
Incorporation	3. The Way of Trinidad and Tobago (hereinafter called “the Association”) is hereby created a body corporate.
Establishment and composition of the board	4. (1) There is hereby established a Board, consisting of seven (7) members including a President and Vice-President. (2) Members of the Board shall be elected by an Annual General Meeting and shall have Annual Audits to establish proper financial responsibility of the Association.
Aims and objectives	5. The aims and objectives of the Association are to: (a) research and to present the gospel of Jesus Christ within Trinidad and Tobago according

to the best methods and in the best way possible for the benefit of the people of Trinidad and Tobago and in accordance with the doctrine of The Way International;

- (b) do all such lawful things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects. That all amendments would conform to the departmental drafting format.

6. The functions of the Association are—

Functions

- (a) Biblical Research, Teaching and Fellowship Ministry.

7. The Association shall in furtherance of its aims, objectives and functions, have the power to—

Powers

- (a) acquire by purchase, transfer, donation, exchange, devise, bequest, grant, gift, conveyance or otherwise any real or personal property or any estate or interest therein;
- (b) accept surrenders or re-conveyances and enter into contracts;
- (c) sell, exchange, demise, mortgage or otherwise dispose of and deal with all property which may for the time being be vested in it subject to any restraint, reservation or condition contained in the document under which it has acquired title;
- (d) sue and be sued in its corporate name;
- (e) have a common seal and alter or change it;
- (f) regulate its own procedure and business; and
- (g) generally to do all things necessary or expedient for the conduct of the affairs of the Association, not provided herein.
