REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 30 of 1999

AN ACT to provide for the Service of Trinidad and
Tobago for the financial year ending on the
30th day of September, 2000.

[Assented to 28th October, 1999]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, Short title
1999/2000.

Issue of
\$14,046,051,697
from Consolidated
Fund authorised

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of fourteen thousand and forty-six million, and fifty-one thousand, six hundred and ninety-seven dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the financial year ending 30th September, 2000 under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the Schedule opposite to a Head is hereby appropriated out of the said sum of fourteen thousand and forty-six million and fifty-one thousand, six hundred and ninety-seven dollars for the purpose specified in relation to that Head in the Estimates for the said year.

Commencement

3. This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October, 1999.
