**Act No. 5 of 2003**

[L.S.]

AN ACT to validate the cancellation of certain postage  
stamps

*[ Assented to 28th February, 2003 ]*

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment  
follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Stamp Duty Short title  
(Validation) Act, 2003.

Interpretation

**2.** In this Act, “the Act” means the Stamp Duty (Special Provisions) Act, 2000.

Validation

**3.** Notwithstanding section 3(1) of the Act, in relation to the payment of stamp duty or fees in accordance with any other written law, the cancellation, between the date of proclamation of the Act, that is to say, November 06, 2000 and the commencement of this Act, of postage stamps affixed to any instrument, is hereby validated.
