AN ACT to amend the Freedom of Information Act, 1999

[Assented to 7th April, 2003]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Freedom of Short title
Information (Amendment) Act, 2003.

Act No. 26 of 1999
amended

2. The Freedom of Information Act is amended—

(a) in section 4, by deleting the definition of “Minister” and substituting the following definition:

“Minister” means the Minister of Government to whom responsibility for information is assigned;”; and

(b) in section 25(3), by inserting after the word “Minister” the words “to whom responsibility for national security is assigned;”.
