REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 19 of 2004

AN ACT to supplement and vary the appropriation of
the sum the issue of which was authorized by the
Appropriation Act, 2004

[Assented to 18th June, 2004]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the Short title
(Supplementation and Variation of Appropriation)
(No. 2) Act, 2004.

Further issue of \$664,805,338 from the Consolidated Fund Schedule I

2. A further issue from the Consolidated Fund in the sum of six hundred and sixty-four million, eight hundred and five thousand, three hundred and thirty-eight dollars is authorized for meeting expenditure for the service of the financial year ending September 30, 2004 and appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in Part I of the Schedule to this Act.

Increase in Heads of Expenditure Act, No. 27 of 2003

3. The sums appropriated to the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule to this Act in the Appropriation Act, 2004 are increased by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part.

Reduction in Heads of Expenditure

4. The sums appropriated to the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule to this Act in the Appropriation Act, 2004 are reduced by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part.

Sums Appropriated in respect of Heads specified in Part II may be utilized. Chap. 69:01

5. The sums appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule to this Act in the Appropriation Act, 2004 and not utilized at the commencement of this Act may be utilized, notwithstanding anything contained in the Exchequer and Audit Act, for the discharge of any liability incurred by reason of the increase in the Expenditure in respect of the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule to this Act.
