Act No. 29 of 2005

[L.S.]

AN ACT to provide for the Service of Trinidad and Tobago
for the financial year ending on the 30th day of
September, 2006.

[Assented to 18th October, 2005]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Short title Appropriation Act, 2006.

Issue from the
Consolidated Fund
authorized

2. (1) The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of thirty thousand, six hundred and thirty-nine million, seven hundred and seventeen thousand, one hundred and ninety-six dollars (\$30,639,717,196) is hereby authorized for meeting expenditure for the service of the financial year ending on the 30th day of September, 2006 under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule hereto.

Schedule

(2) The sum specified in the Schedule opposite to each Head of Expenditure is hereby appropriated out of the said sum of thirty thousand, six hundred and thirty-nine million, seven hundred and seventeen thousand, one hundred and ninety-six dollars (\$30,639,717,196) for the purpose specified in relation to that Head in the Estimates of Expenditure for the said financial year.

Commencement

3. This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October, 2005.
