AN ACT to vary the appropriation of the sum the issue of
which was authorised by the Appropriation
(Financial Year 2017) Act, 2016

[Assented to 22nd May, 2017]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance (Variation of Short title
Appropriation) (Financial Year 2017) Act, 2017.

<p>Interpretation Act No. 9 of 2016</p>	<p>2. In this Act, “the Appropriation Act, 2017” means the Appropriation (Financial Year 2017) Act, 2016.</p>
<p>Increase in Heads of Expenditure Schedule</p>	<p>3. The sums appropriated to the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule to this Act by the Appropriation Act, 2017 are increased by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part.</p>
<p>Reduction in Heads of Expenditure Schedule</p>	<p>4. The sums appropriated to the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule to this Act by the Appropriation Act, 2017 are reduced by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part.</p>
<p>Sums appropriated in respect of Heads specified in Part II may be utilised Schedule Chap. 69:01</p>	<p>5. The sums appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule to this Act by the Appropriation Act, 2017 and not utilised at the commencement of this Act may be utilised, notwithstanding anything contained in the Exchequer and Audit Act, for the discharge of any liability incurred by reason of the increase in the expenditure in respect of the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule to this Act.</p>
