Act No. 16 of 2019

AN ACT to amend the Retiring Allowances (Legislative Service) Act, Chap. 2:03; the Prime Minister's Pensions Act, Chap. 2:51; and the Judges Salaries and Pensions Act, Chap. 6:02

[Assented to 10th July, 2019]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Short title
Miscellaneous Provisions (Pensions) Act, 2019.

Chap. 2:03 amended

2. The Retiring Allowances (Legislative Service) Act is amended by—

- (a) renumbering section 6B as section 6B(1);
and
- (b) inserting after section 6B(1) as renumbered, the following subsections:

“ (2) For the avoidance of doubt, subsection (1) shall not be construed as authorising the payment of a revised retiring allowance with respect to a fifth anniversary which occurred before the coming into force of that subsection.

(3) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a person referred to in that subsection who ceased to hold office before 25th June, 2019 is entitled to the revised retiring allowance referred to in that subsection as of 25th June, 2019 and thereafter on every fifth anniversary referred to in that subsection.”.

Chap. 2:51 amended

3. The Prime Minister’s Pensions Act is amended by—

- (a) renumbering section 4A as section 4A(1);
and
- (b) inserting after section 4A(1) as renumbered, the following subsections:

“ (2) For the avoidance of doubt, subsection (1) shall not be construed as authorising the payment of a revised pension with respect to a fifth anniversary which occurred before the coming into force of that subsection.

(3) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a person referred to in that subsection who ceased to hold office before 25th June, 2019 is entitled to the revised pension referred to in that subsection as of 25th June, 2019 and thereafter on every fifth anniversary referred to in that subsection.”.

4. The Judges Salaries and Pensions Act is amended Chap. 6:02 amended by—

- (a) renumbering section 11A as section 11A(1); and
- (b) inserting after section 11A(1) as renumbered, the following subsections:

“ (2) For the avoidance of doubt, subsection (1) shall not be construed as authorising the payment of a revised pension with respect to a fifth anniversary which occurred before the coming into force of that subsection.

“ (3) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a person referred to in that subsection who ceased to hold office before 25th June, 2019 is entitled to the revised pension referred to in that subsection as of 25th June, 2019 and thereafter on every fifth anniversary referred to in that subsection.”.
