**AN ACT to amend the Constitution of Trinidad and
Tobago**

THE CONSTITUTION (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2001

Explanatory Note

(These notes form no part of the Bill but are intended only to indicate its general purport)

The purpose of this Bill is to amend the Constitution to authorise the employment on contract from the private sector of persons to perform the duties of permanent secretary in the public service of Trinidad and Tobago.

Section 85(1) of the Constitution stipulates, *inter alia*, that the office of the permanent secretary shall be a public office.

Clause 2 seeks to amend section 85 to state that the office of permanent secretary may be either a public office or a contract position.
