THE STAMP DUTY (VALIDATION) BILL, 2001

Explanatory Note

(These notes form no part of the Bill but are intended only to indicate its general purport)

The object of the Bill is to validate documents and instruments in respect of which stamp duty and fees were paid by way of postage stamps instead of money, after the coming into force of the Stamp Duty (Special Provisions) Act, 2000 on 6th November, 2001.

BILL

AN ACT to validate the cancellation of certain
postage stamps

[, 2001]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as ^{Enactment}
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Stamp Duty ^{Short title}
(Validation) Act, 2001.

2. In this Act, “the Act” means the Stamp Duty ^{Interpretation}
(Special Provisions) Act, 2000.

Validation

3. Notwithstanding section 3(1) of the Act, in relation to the payment of stamp duty or fees in accordance with any other written law, the cancellation, between the date of proclamation of the Act, that is to say, 6th November, 2000 and the commencement of this Act, of postage stamps affixed to any instrument, is hereby validated.
