

THE OLD AGE PENSIONS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2001

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(These notes form no part of the Bill but are intended only to indicate its general purport)

This Bill seeks to amend the Old Age Pensions Act, Chap. 32:02 to increase the amount of the old age pension grant.

Clause 1 contains the short title of the Act.

Clause 2 would seek to amend section 3 of the Act by increasing the old age pension grant from seven hundred and twenty dollars to eight hundred dollars per month. This clause also contains the commencement provision.

A BILL

AN ACT to amend the Old Age Pensions Act, Chap. 32:02

Enactment

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Old Age Pensions (Amendment) Act, 2001.

Section 3 amended

2. (1) Section 3 of the Act is amended by deleting the words “seven hundred and twenty dollars” wherever appearing and substituting the words “eight hundred dollars”.

(2) Subsection (1) is deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of October, 2001.
