(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1999 VALIDATION  
BILL, 2001

**Explanatory Note**

(These notes form no part of the Bill but are intended only  
to indicate its general purport)

The purpose of this Bill is to validate the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1999 ("the Regulations"), which were published on the 14th October, 1999.

The Regulations were purported to have been made by the President under section 100 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act, Chap. 48:50 ("the Act"). However, section 100 of the Act empowers the Minister with responsibility for Transport, to make the Regulations.

The effect of the Bill will, therefore, be to validate the Regulations and consequently all actions done pursuant to them from the 14th October, 1999.

## **BILL**

AN ACT to validate the Motor Vehicles and Road  
Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1999

WHEREAS it is provided by section 100 of the Motor <sup>Preamble</sup>  
Vehicles and Road Traffic Act, Chap. 48:50 that the  
Minister may make Regulations, *inter alia*, in respect  
of the inspection of motor and other vehicles at the  
times, places and manner of such inspection:

And whereas the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1999, (hereinafter referred to as “the Regulations”), were purported to have been made on the 9th day of September, 1998, by the President of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago under section 100 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act, 48:50:

And whereas the Regulations were approved in the House of Representatives on the 29th July, 1999 and in the Senate on the 10th August, 1999:

And whereas the Regulations were published on the 14th October, 1999.

And whereas it is necessary and expedient to validate the Regulations.

Enactment            ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as follows:—

Short title            **1.** This Act may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1999 Validation Act, 2001.

Legal Notice No. 197 of 1999 validated    **2.** The Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1999, purporting to have been made on the 9th day of September, 1998 by the President of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago under section 100 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act and approved in the House of Representatives on the 29th July, 1999 and in the Senate on the 10th August, 1999, shall have, and be deemed to have had effect from the date of publication, namely the 14th October, 1999, as if made by the Minister to whom responsibility for transport is assigned.
