

THE REGISTRAR GENERAL (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2002

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(These notes form no part of the Bill but are intended only to indicate its general purport)

This Bill seeks to amend the Registrar General Act to permit the Registrar General to receive cash from persons who are in line and awaiting service in the Registrar General's Department, at 3:00 p.m. and later on week days.

A BILL

AN ACT to amend the Registrar General Act, Chap. 19:03

Enactment	ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as follows:
Short title	1. This Act may be cited as the Registrar General (Amendment) Bill, 2002.
Section 9 amended	2. The Act is amended in section 9 by repealing subsection (2) and substituting the following subsection: “ (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), the Registrar General may, with the approval of the Minister where in the opinion of the Minister, time permits, by notification in <i>the Gazette</i> and in at least one daily newspaper in circulation in Trinidad and Tobago – (a) close the Office for the transaction of business on any working day; or (b) reduce the hours (times) referred to in subsection (1).”.
