THE STAMP DUTY (VALIDATION) BILL, 2002

Explanatory Note

The object of the Bill is to validate documents and instruments in respect of which stamp duty and fees were paid by way of postage stamps instead of money, after the coming into force of the Stamp Duty (Special Provisions) Act, 2000 on November 06, 2001.
