AN ACT to amend the Adoption of Children Act, 2000

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1. This Act may, be cited as the Adoption of Children Short title
(Amendment) Act, 2002.

2. Section 2 of the Adoption of Children Act is amended by deleting the definition of the word “Court” therein and substituting the following:

“Court” means the Court with responsibility for family matters.
