AN ACT to amend the State Lands Act, Chap. 57:01

THE STATE LANDS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2002

Explanatory Note

(These notes form no part of the Bill but are intended only to indicate its general purport)

The purpose of the Bill is to amend section 10 of the State Lands Act, Chap. 57:01 to remove the requirement for—

- (a) every lease of State lands to be made under the Public Seal of Trinidad and Tobago; and
- (b) every lease of State lands to be delivered to the Registrar General together with a map, plan or diagram of the land leased and to be registered under the Real Property Ordinance, Ch. 27 No. 11.

BILL

AN ACT to amend the State Lands Act, Chap. 57:01

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the State Lands Short title
(Amendment) Act, 2002.

Section 10 amended
Chap. 57:01

2. Section 10 of the State Lands Act is amended—

- (a) in subsection (1), by deleting the words “and every lease of State Lands”; and
- (b) by repealing subsections (2) and (3) and substituting the following subsection:

“(2) Every lease of State lands under the Public Seal of Trinidad and Tobago shall be registered by the Registrar General in the same manner as a deed, on being tendered to him for that purpose.”.
