

THE STUDENTS' REVOLVING LOAN FUND (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2006

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(These notes form no part of the Bill but are intended only to indicate its general purport)

This Bill seeks to amend the Students' Revolving Loan Fund Act, Chap. 39:05 ("the Act") to provide for the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry with responsibility for Tertiary Education, to replace the Chief Personnel Officer as Chairman of the Board of Management of the Fund and other consequential amendments.

Clause 1 states the short title of the Bill.

Clause 2(a) seeks to amend section 2 of the Act to amend the definition of "Minister" to mean the member of Cabinet to whom responsibility for Tertiary Education is assigned.

Clause 2(b) seeks to amend section 6 of the Act by deleting the words "Chief Personnel Officer" wherever they occur and substituting them with the words "Permanent Secretary of the Ministry with responsibility for Tertiary Education".

A BILL

AN ACT to amend the Students' Revolving Loan Fund Act to provide for the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry with responsibility for Tertiary Education, to replace the Chief Personnel Officer as Chairman of the Board of Management of the Students' Revolving Loan Fund

Enactment **ENACTED** by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as follows:

Short title 1. This Act may be cited as the Students' Revolving Loan Fund (Amendment) Act, 2006.

2. The Students' Revolving Loan Fund Act is amended –

(a) in section 2, by deleting the definition of “Minister” and substituting the following:

““ Minister” means the member of Cabinet to whom responsibility for Tertiary Education is assigned”; and

(b) in section 6 –

(i) in subsection (2)(a), by deleting the words “Chief Personnel Officer” wherever they occur and substituting the words “Permanent Secretary of the Ministry with responsibility for Tertiary Education”; and

- (ii) in subsection (6), by deleting the words “Chief Personnel Officer” and substituting the words “Permanent Secretary of the Ministry with responsibility for Tertiary Education.”.
