THE FINANCE (SUPPLEMENTATION AND VARIATION OF  
APPROPRIATION) (FINANCIAL YEAR 2012) BILL, 2013

**Explanatory Note**

(These notes form no part of the Bill but are intended only to indicate its general purport)

The object of the Bill is to supplement and vary the appropriation provided for by the Appropriation (Financial Year 2012) Act, 2011 and to authorize the utilization of any sums accruing from a reduction of expenditure under certain Heads of Expenditure for the purpose of meeting any liability incurred through the increase in expenditure under other Heads.

# BILL

AN ACT to supplement and vary the appropriation of the sum the issue of which was authorized by the Appropriation (Financial Year 2012) Act, 2011

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance Short title (Supplementation and Variation of Appropriation) (Financial Year 2012) Act, 2013.

Further issue of \$1,568,166,725 from the Consolidated Fund	<b>2.</b> A further issue from the Consolidated Fund in the sum of one thousand, five hundred and sixty-eight million, one hundred and sixty-six thousand, seven hundred and twenty-five dollars is authorized for meeting expenditure for the service of the financial year ending September 30, 2012 and appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in Part I of the Schedule to this Act.
Schedule	
Increase in Heads of Expenditure Act No.19 of 2011	<b>3.</b> The sums appropriated to the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule to this Act by the Appropriation Act (Financial Year 2012) Act, 2011 are increased by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part.
Reduction in Heads of Expenditure	<b>4.</b> The sums appropriated to the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule to this Act by the Appropriation Act (Financial Year 2012) Act, 2011 are reduced by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part.
Sums appropriated in respect of Heads specified in Part II may be utilized  Chap. 69:01	<b>5.</b> The sums appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule to this Act by the Appropriation Act (Financial Year 2012) Act, 2011 and not utilized at the commencement of this Act may be utilized, notwithstanding anything contained in the Exchequer and Audit Act, for the discharge of any liability incurred by reason of the increase in the expenditure in respect of the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule to this Act.
