An Act to supplement the appropriation of the sum, the issue of which was authorised by the Appropriation (Financial Year 2022) Act, 2021

[Assented to 24th May, 2022]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance Short title (Supplementary Appropriation) (Financial Year 2022) Act, 2022.

Further issue of \$3,081,703,900 from the Consolidated Fund 2. A further issue from the Consolidated Fund in the sum of three thousand and eighty-one million, seven hundred and three thousand, nine hundred dollars is authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the financial year ending September 30, 2022 and appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in the Schedule to this Act.
