A Bill entitled, “An Act to amend the Prevention of Corruption Act, the Proceeds of Crime Act, the Anti-Terrorism Act, the National Insurance Act, the Financial Intelligence Unit of Trinidad and Tobago Act, the Income Tax Act, the Corporation Tax Act, the Petroleum Taxes Act, the Registration of Business Names Act, the Companies Act, the Tax Information Agreements (United States of America) Act, the Non-Profit Organisation Act, the Tax Information Exchange Agreements Act, the Mutual Administrative Assistance in Tax Matters Act, the Miscellaneous Provisions (Trustees, Exchequer and Audit, the Minister of Finance (Incorporation) Act, Income Tax, Companies, Partnerships, Securities, Tax Information Exchange Agreements, the Non-Profit Organisations and Mutual Administrative Assistance in Tax Matters) Act and the Miscellaneous Provisions (Registrar General, Companies, Registration of Business Names and Non-Profit Organisations) Act, 2024.” *

A Bill entitled, “An Act to make jurisdiction for matters of a civil nature exercisable in a division of the Judiciary to be known as the “Civil Division” and to make jurisdiction for specified civil matters exercisable in a sub-division of the Civil Division known as the “Civil Court”, to make jurisdiction for small-valued claims exercisable in a sub-division of the “Civil Division to be known as the “Small Claims Courts”, to make jurisdiction for estates administration business exercisable in a sub-division of the Civil Division known as the “Estates Administration Office” and for related matters. *
